He is sick and locks himself in the little house when the wife walks to go and ask for help for people to come and cook or get her some water.

The old man opened the door for us and wanted to at least touch the food that was brought for him and his wife. He was so grateful for to us and we told him about the people that have been sending the money for them. He appreciated as he said that bringing him the food is the best thing that he can receive since he can no longer go out and buy it himself.
